NUISANCE ORDINANCE NO. 436 A

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 436, AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING NUISANCES IN THE CITY OF FOSSIL

WHEREAS: The City of Fossil has Ordinance No. 436 regarding Nuisances, and

WHEREAS: The City of Fossil has identified more nuisances to be addressed, and

WHEREAS: Ordinance No. 436 Section 1.070 Subsection (B) and Subsection (C) shall read:

- (B). No owner or person in charge of property may permit or cause a nuisance affecting public health. The following are nuisances affecting public health.
 - (1) Debris on Private Property: Accumulations of household garbage and other refuse located on private property that are not removed within a reasonable time and that affect the health, safety or welfare of the City.
- (C) The enumeration of nuisances in subsection A and B of this section shall not limit the power of the City Council to investigate or declare any other condition a nuisance which is within the scope of Section 1.020 (I) of the original Ordinance 436.

REPEAL OF PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND SAVINGS CLAUSE

To the extent that any prior ordinance of the City of Fossil are inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance or the original Ordinance No. 436, they are repealed, PROVIDED HOWEVER, such ordinances shall remain in force for prosecution, conviction and punishment of persons who violate such ordinances or provisions before the effective date of this ordinance.

EMERGENCY:

It is hereby determined and declared that the existing conditions are such that the passage of this ordinance is necessary of the immediate preservation of the peace, health, general welfare and safety of the City of Fossil and this ordinance shall be in full force and effective immediately upon and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Fossil, Oregon.
