This Work Session is called to order to discuss the ongoing concerns related to the Bowerman Trail. The discussion will include reports of vehicles driving on the trail and blocking access points, as well as issues related to weed control, vegetation management, and general maintenance. The purpose of this work session is to review current conditions, consider potential solutions such as enforcement measures, signage, or barriers, and provide direction to staff. The meeting focused on addressing issues related to vehicle access and maintenance on the Bowerman Trail and Waite Street. The group discussed concerns about vehicles parking on the trail and potential damage, with Sally expressing the need for easier access to maintain the trail. They agreed to install temporary barriers, such as T-posts and rope, to prevent unauthorized vehicle access. The plan was to implement these changes before spring, with the hope of making the trail more accessible and preserving its condition.
